

POST-PROCEDURAL CARE

Change your pillow case. Use an old pillow case that you don't mind getting stained with your home care ointment or body fluids. No heavy exercise for 72 hours. No spas, swimming or whirlpools for at least 14 days. No hot tubs for 72 hours.

EYELINER

Expect light to moderate swelling and redness. If your eyes are irritated and painful, contact your doctor. If your eyes are mildly irritated, you may use an over the counter eye gel/lubricant, like GenTeal® to keep the surface of the eye hydrated. A cold pack may be used to minimize swelling the day of and the day after the procedure at 10 minute intervals only. Apply Aquaphor® healing ointment prior to showering as well as four times daily for four days following the procedure. Make sure you use a minimal amount (a glazed donut not an iced cupcake) applied with clean, washed hands. Q-Tips are too abrasive and may remove new skin holding your pigment. Prior to healing, replace all of your eye makeup to avoid contaminating your newly healed tattooed eyelids. Wait a minimum of two weeks before having your eyelashes tinted, permed or eyelash extensions applied. For proper color deposit, a minimum of 30 days is required before your follow-up application can be scheduled.

EYEBROWS

Do not be concerned with the color depth (darkness) of your eyebrows during the first four days. Remember, you were given a small, non-abrasive, washcloth and instructions to gently wash the newly tattooed eyebrows at the end of your fourth day. Prior to the fourth day, your eyebrows will feel tender to the touch and may feel like a slight sunburn. Your home care ointment, Aquaphor®, must be applied to the tattooed area prior to showering and additionally every four hours. Please wash your hands before applying the ointment to your eyebrows with your finger. It's very important to gently press the Aquaphor® into the design. This creates a seal on the skin that limits air or water from entering your new design and accelerating your healing. The slower a tattoo heals, the better it holds color.

NO RUBBING THE OINTMENT INTO THE SKIN ... IT WILL REMOVE YOUR NEW SKIN CAUSING EXTREME COLOR LOSS!

If your eyebrow itches while it's healing, take a clean finger and press on the area that itches. The itch will instantly go away. Tweezing, waxing or eyebrow threading may be done at the end of one week. Wait two weeks before tinting the eyebrow hairs or using eyebrow hair fixatives.

Do not use ANY of these products on the tattooed eyebrows EVER:

- Glycolic cleansers, toners, moisturizers etc.

- Retinol ointments.

- Hair growing products.

- Sugar acids.

- Microdermabrasion or lasers.

LIP LINER / FULL LIP COLOR

Do not panic. You will lighten. Expect moderate swelling, weeping of lymphatic fluid and tenderness. If you start showing any signs of blistering and are not on an anti-viral, as I had instructed, call your doctor and request an oral prescription be phoned in to your local pharmacy. Ointments will help, however, ointment won't stop the virus and you may experience extreme swelling, tenderness as well as color loss. Straws are great with your water, coffee and drinks while healing. Gently apply your Aquaphor® before brushing your teeth, getting into the shower and several times a day until your lips are completely healed. DO NOT encourage your lips to peel faster than nature has planned. After the lips have peeled, the new skin is opaque (milky or foggy) masking your color. As the new cells mature over the next two weeks, they will become more translucent, revealing your healed deposit of color. Due to the quick healing of lips, it is not uncommon to have up to 70% of the color not hold, that is why we make sure you commit to a minimum of one follow-up application for more color deposit. If you needed the anti viral oral medication prior to your first application, you will also need it for any additional applications.

AREOLA COLOR RESTORATION

Keep area away from water for 48 hours. Keep moist with Aquaphor® for four to five days. No vigorous exercise for 72 hours.
